



FAST FACTS

The Pioneer Trails Recreation Area, located 1.25 miles east and 1.0 mile north of Aurora, Nebraska, features a 43 surface-acre lake which can store 277 acre feet of water.

Constructed on a tributary of Lincoln Creek in 1986, the project was designed to provide flood control, aquifer recharge, wildlife habitat and recreational opportunities.

Target shooting is prohibited; Discharging center-fire and rim-fire rifles, handguns and muzzle-loading firearms is prohibited unless a special trapping permit is issued by the District. Hunting is allowed within the boundary line north of County Road 14 except for a buffer zone of 250 feet directly north of County Road 14.

Facilities at the site include picnic tables, cooking grills and fire rings, as well as a hand pump and a wooden footbridge across the dam spillway.
